The Wraparound Services Specialist Job Responsibilities

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Implement the Survivor Support Services Program
- Implement discharge criteria and protocol/procedure
- Document needs, goals, and progress of survivors as well as making referrals as necessary
- Track distribution of goods & services provided to survivors
- Accompany participant's interviews/investigations with law enforcement as needed for the survivor cases
- Maintain community partnerships with other agencies
- Communicate on an ongoing basis, checking in with active clients
- Implement program objectives and performance standards as directed by management
- Maintain healthy boundaries with clients
- Maintain confidentiality of information and protect anonymity in survivor relationships
- Participate effectively as a team member through communication, cooperation, information sharing, and problem-solving
- Attend and complete training/conferences to a satisfactory level
- Any other tasks or duties as assigned
- Balance and keep a flexible schedule
- Orchestrate programs outside of the shelter that provide services or goods to survivors or vulnerable populations
